CATAWBA REGIONAL OFFERS CERTIFIED TRAINING FOR LOCAL PLANNING OFFICIALS & STAFF

2008 FALL SCHEDULE

Catawba Regional Council of Governments is authorized by the SC State Advisory Committee to offer training for local planning officials and staff members pursuant to the Code of Laws of South Carolina, §6-29-1340. The mandatory training requirements must be satisfied annually by all appointed board members and planning staff. During the first two years of this program, our certified trainers delivered approximately 600 hours of instruction to over 100 individuals in the Catawba Region.

Catawba Regional will again provide this valuable instruction to our members at our facility in Rock Hill. The six-hour orientation training is designed specifically for newly appointed members of the Planning Commission, Board of Zoning Appeals, Historic Review Board and their respective staff. We will offer these sessions in two installments from 6:00 p.m. to 9:30 p.m. The cost for each participant is \$50 for both Sessions I & II and includes materials and boxed deli meals.

For our members who have completed the orientation training, we will provide a variety of opportunities to help them meet the three-hour continuing education requirement. These sessions will be more informal and will use either audio- or video-conference formats. Each session will last from 6:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m. and includes materials and a boxed deli meal for a fee of \$25. Participants will need to attend one of the sessions to satisfy the state-mandated training requirement.
